Rich and rounded with flavours of candied fruit, marzipan, toast, white chocolate, and caramel; refined acidity offering a fresh finish

Full flavoured, biscuity and very well balanced with an elegant and refined finish and superb length on the palate

55% Chardonnay for freshness, flavour & structure with 45% Pinot Noir for depth and character; acacia honey and fresh almonds on the nose whilst dried apricots and toasted brioche combine for length and finish; the ultimate glass of champagne

Intense varietal aroma with notes of grapefruit, citrus blossom, apricots and a background of cassis; good intensity, concentration and balance, with a long lingering aftertaste

Peter Mertes - Pfalz - Germany

Delicious with or without food; full of grass and herbs; a whiff of white blossoms and tropical fruit; beautifully refreshing

Grenache Blanc - 2014 **£22.00**

Petit Papillon

Languedoc - Roussillon

Aromas of white fruits lead to a crisp, fruity palate that is both easy-drinking and refreshing

Inzolia - IGT - 2014 **£23.00**

Legato - Sicily

Fresh pear and almond notes infuse this delicately structured, more stylish than Pinot Grigio; dry yet rounded, with a refreshing finish



Chenin Blanc - 2015 **£24.00**

Klein Rust - Stellenbosch - South Africa

Soft dried apricots with an oak and vanilla undertow followed by white fleshed peaches, almond paste, and windfall oranges - delightful with food

Chardonnay - 2014 - La Croix Belle **£25.00**

Languedoc - Roussillon - France

Creamy notes mingle with citrus, lime and apple flavours, leading up to a clean finish with subtle candied fruit

Barrel Fermented Viura

Castillo Clavijo - Rioja - Spain

Fresh, intense aromas of fruits and white flowers with a palate dominated by apple and pears; fruity and fresh on the palate with a pleasant finish and no oak; 90% Viura - 10% Malvasia

Torrentés - 2012/14 **£26.00**

Tilia - Salto - Argentina

Dry, elegant rendition of this aromatic grape packed with vibrant flavour and good natural acidity with white peach and floral notes such as rose and jasmine

Picpoul de Pinet - 2015 - Mas Peuch **£27.00**

Languedoc - Roussillon - France

A very easy-drinking dry white, cool-fermented with an aromatic bouquet of green apples; a simple crisp wine that goes perfectly with seafood and light lunches



Semillon - Sauvignon - 2015 **£27.00**

Bergerac - Chateau Des Eyssards

Cool-fermented in stainless-steel to give a crisp and fruity wine with an aromatic bouquet redolent of russet apples - delicious and not as dry as some wines

Bursting with Viognier character of apricots, peaches and preserved citrus fruit; the palate is both smooth and fresh, with hints of spice and a good finish

Stellenbosch - South Africa
Delicious Chardonnay with mellow oak and tropical fruit notes - quite a stunner of a wine - needs trying to appreciate
- Albariño - A-2-0 - 2014** £33.00
Rias Baixas - Spain
From the coolest part of Rias Baixas, this wine bursts with juicy character showing pear, citrus fruit, musky perfume and hints of mineral and spice; clean, intense and very long on the palate
- Pinot Gris - 2015** £34.00
Ara - Marlborough - New Zealand
Flavours of pear, and honey with a hints of citrus; matches well with pork and poultry; nectarine on the nose, well textured palate and fresh grapefruit for the crisp finish
- Lugana - 2015** £34.00
Bulgarini - Lombardy - Italy
Unusual wine full of fresh vibrant fruit and flavour not unlike good un-oaked white burgundy - a real find and one to try; 100% Trebbiano grapes

Spy Valley - Marlborough - New Zealand 
Lively aromas of grapefruit and gooseberry with passion fruit and melon flavours providing richness and weight balanced by the citrus-dominated backbone; full and dry with a minerally finish

Morgassi - Piedmont
Delicate and floral with plenty of citrus fruit flavours and a very fresh finish

Suavia - Veneto
Crisp, refreshing and light, with flavours of apple and citrus fruits, accompanied by a very subtle creamy texture

Refined Sauvignon, with a lively lemony, grassy medium-bodied palate, some flinty minerality and a dry, elegant finish

Classic burgundy full of freshness, rich in fruit with a fine, elegant finish of red apple & nuts; a good mineral undercurrent; an elegant palate allows fruit to flow through; supple and citrusy when young developing layers of complexity with age

Lucien Crochet - Bué - Loire
Citrus fruits, blossom, peach and pear on the nose; nice pure entry, fruity and crisp on the palate; good length and classic mineral flavours - classic Sancerre

Wonderfully rich and refreshingly; zesty with fragrant aromas of elderflower, jasmine and pear with a slightly honeyed texture

Domaine Paul Jaboulet Aine
Exotic spice and caramel aromas with a light background of oak and nutty flavours, candied fruit and vanilla on the palate - perfect Marsanne-Viognier blend ready to drink now

Vietti - Piedmont
Pale yellow colour with fresh floral, citrus and melon aromas with just a hint of almonds; unoaked, dry, medium bodied, well balanced wine with crisp acidity and a lingering finish

Restrained, peachy and flinty with a lovely minerality; good balance, fresh with a hint of cinnamon spice

Tenuta di Campomaggio - Radda in Chianti - Sienna

Beautifully composed wine, in the modern style, combining spicy hints of vanilla and cloves with pure cherry and blackcurrant fruit; ages for 12 months in oak, the palate is full and silky, with great finesse and a rich, long finish; 100% Sangiovese

Chalone Estate Pinot Noir - 2011

Monterey - California

Full with layers of rich aroma vanilla followed by pear; French oak imparts enticing nuances of hazelnut and brioche; flavors fill the mouth with pear, green apple, a hint of peach and mineral

Douro - 2013 - Quinta do Valado

Peso da Régua - Portugal

Aromas of ripe redcurrant and raspberry as well as some hints of violets. Well-balanced in the mouth, a result of the softness of Tinta Barroca, the body and length of Touriga Franca and the elegance of Tinta Roriz

Bolney Estates - UK - Sussex

A good example of a cold climate pinot noir; a fragrant, well balanced, medium bodied wine full of red cherry flavours and hints of toasted oak and hints of cedar-wood which give a lovely complexity in the bouquet and on the palate

Fruity and generous with aromas of woodland fruits, moss or truffle mixed with woody notes; the structure is ample, full and charming during the first years and is enhanced by further ageing; very smooth and drinking very well now; 100% cabernet franc

Bodegas Tabula Damana - Castilla y León - Spain

Rich, deep cherry-red, expressive Ribera del Duero, with aromas of roasted fruit, vanilla, and some herbal brightness; the palate is sweet, broad yet elegantly balanced, with a certain chocolatey smoothness; 100% Tempranillo

Côtes du Rhône - 2013

Les Deux Albion - Château de Saint Cosme - France

Fruity and generous with aromas of woodland fruits, moss or truffle mixed with woody notes; the structure is ample, full and with notes of cherry, raspberries and pepper; blend of Syrah, Grenache, Carignan, Mourvèdre and Clairette co-fermented

Morgenhof Estate Merlot - 2010

Stellenbosch - S.A.

Lovely ruby colour and a nose full of black cherries, mulberries and spice; flavours carry through and finishes on a lingering, rich fruit palate with a smooth aftertaste; 18 months in French oak, 20% new barrels; 100% merlot

Chateau Patache d'Aux - 2006

Médoc - cru bourgeois

Owned by the Lapula family since 1964, this is a classic claret matured in 30% new oak to produce elegance and grip and a long, satisfying finish; rich and dense on the palate with splendid, glossy fruit and firm, ripe tannins. 70% Cabernet Sauvignon plus 20% Merlot, 7% Cabernet Franc & 3% Petit Verdot

Château Viramière - 2011

St Emillion Grand Cru - Bordeaux

A deep rich wine with a powerful aroma of the hills on which it is grown - a nose of tobacco, blackcurrant and spice; the palate is well balanced with a solid tannic structure and a long finish; will benefit from decanting; predominance of Merlot for roundness with Cabernet Sauvignon for structure

Dinastino Vivanco - Rioja

Complex aromas with subtle spicy notes and ripe black fruit touches, leading to a generous, intense palate full of plums, raisins and chocolate; beautiful balance of fruit and oak, with a long, persistent finish; 100% Tempranillo

Fattoria del Cerro - Carbonaia
15 months in mixed oak brings ripe red berry fruit and a hint of vanilla and a full, rounded and well balanced wine with a sweet, lingering aftertaste; 100% Prugnolo Gentile 13.5% alc
- Chateau Cissac - 2008** **£53.00**
Cru Bourgeois - Bordeaux - France
Good medium weight wine showing elements of cedar wood, dark cherry, blackcurrant & star anise; medium tannins with good acidity and a long length; perfect for drinking today; 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot and 5% Petit Verdot
- St Joseph - Le Grand Pompée - 2009** **£55.00**
Domaine Paul Jaboulet Aine
Deep black fruit on the nose - dark cherries, blackberries and blackcurrants that carry onto the palate with added woody and smoky notes; a complex spicy palate leading to a balanced texture and a long finish; beautifully mature 100% Syrah
- Montefalco Sagratino - 2006** **£57.00**
Perticaia - Umbria
A generous mix of ripe blackberries and firm mineral flavours leads to a medium-full body with a creaminess on the palate; a mix of 70% Sangiovese, 15% Sagrantino and 15% Colorino grapes
- Le Volte Dell'Ornellaia - 2011** **£59.00**
Tuscany - Italy
Producers of one of Italy's most celebrated Bordeaux-inspired wines, Ornellaia have created Le Volte as an approachable, early drinking 'Super-Tuscan' blend; a rich black fruit core giving a firm structure with weight lifted by fresh red fruit acidity
- Volnay - Veilles Vignes - 2010** **£63.00**
Roche de Bellene - Côtes d'Or - Beaune
Comprises old vine village Volnay, blended with Premiers Crus Santenots and Caille; Mid/deep purple in colour, there are flowers, fine red fruit through the middle with a touch of barrel toast; this is not an over concentrated Volnay, as some are this year; 100% pinot noir; 13% abv
- Chateau Lanessan - 2005** **£66.00**
Cru Bourgeois - Haut Médoc - Bordeaux
This soft and supple wine consistently shows amongst the best in it's classification; the wine shows elements of jammy black & red fruits, tobacco but with great depth of concentration & firm but not harsh tannins; 75% Cabernet Sauvignon, 20% Merlot, 3% Cabernet Franc 2% Petit Verdot

- Chateauneuf du Pape - 2007** **£69.00**
Domaine de la Charbonnière
Cuvée Mourre des Perdrix
An elegant, harmonious wine, this is seductive, charming and very complete, with admirable concentration and freshness with a rounded texture and slightly jammy notes of plum, fig and blackberry fruit laid softly over a mineral streak; open and juicy through to the finish, picking up blueberry and fruitcake hints that balance the forward fruit; a blend of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre; 15% alc.

Talenti - Piedmont - Italy
Deep ruby red with a complex aroma of ripe red berries and dried flowers; on the palette, crushed violets, tobacco creates a smooth velvety texture after nearly 3 years on barrel and 3 years in bottle; 100% Sangiovese

Nicolis
Deep dark garnet colour with a powerful and aristocratic nose of ripe fruit, jam, cocoa, walnut, tobacco and leather; elegant and powerful wine with a distinct spicy bouquet, with utterly distinctive flavours; it shows an impressive balance between smoothness, warmth and crispness, austerity and richness; endless long lasting; Corvina 65% - Rondinella 20% - Molinara 5% Croatia 10%
- Chambolle-Musigny - 2008** **£84.00**
Domaine Drouhin-Laroze
Bright red berry coulis notes on the nose; easily accessible on the palate; plenty of flesh and good weight with silky tannins; well balanced and retaining a lightness of touch thanks to crisp acidity and fine tannins; this will offer much Burgundian pleasure; 13% alc.; 100% Pinot Noir

1er Cru - Clos des Grandes Vignes

We can supply you with small quantities of our wines and for bigger deliveries we can put you in touch with our suppliers

Where still wine is served by the glass the quantity is as follows:

Corkage is charged as a bottle of house wine per (75cl) bottle served

Wines on this list may (most certainly) contain Sulphites and may contain egg or milk products. Sulphites are present in almost all wines, as a preservative. It is used in winemaking because of its antioxidant and antibacterial properties. Under EU legislation we are required to inform you of food and drink we sell that has sulphur dioxide (sulphites, SO₂) content above 10mg. per kilo or litre. SO₂ plays a very important role in maintaining a wine's freshness. Without it, most wines would not keep. We have checked our wine list and the labels, and all state that sulphites are present, as they must do above 10mg. levels. 'Organic' wines usually have no added sulphur dioxide, but it is created naturally anyway in the fermentation process.

The actual amounts in each bottle we don't know, but as a guide the average is about 80mg./litre. Red wines need less sulphites, and an average of about 50mg. is likely. White wines more, around 120mg., and sweet white wines especially, with up to 350mg. per litre. But please see this in context. Other foodstuffs can contain larger amounts of sulphites, especially dried fruits, like raisins and sultanas, which have a 1,000mg./kilo
